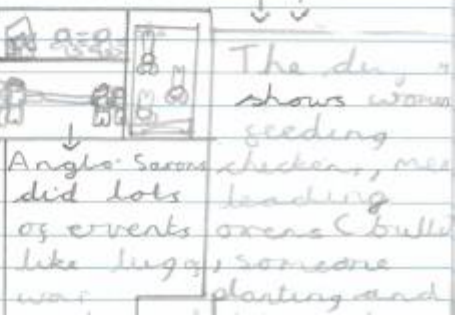
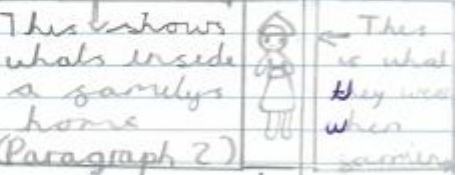
What jobs did they do?

the villages. Men wrestled. Only men led the oxen and boys took part (bulls) carrying in these competitions heavy, wooden ploughs. Children and boys who didn't take part in competitions would play big games of war, while other Anglo-Saxons played village ball games with a large capacity of players.

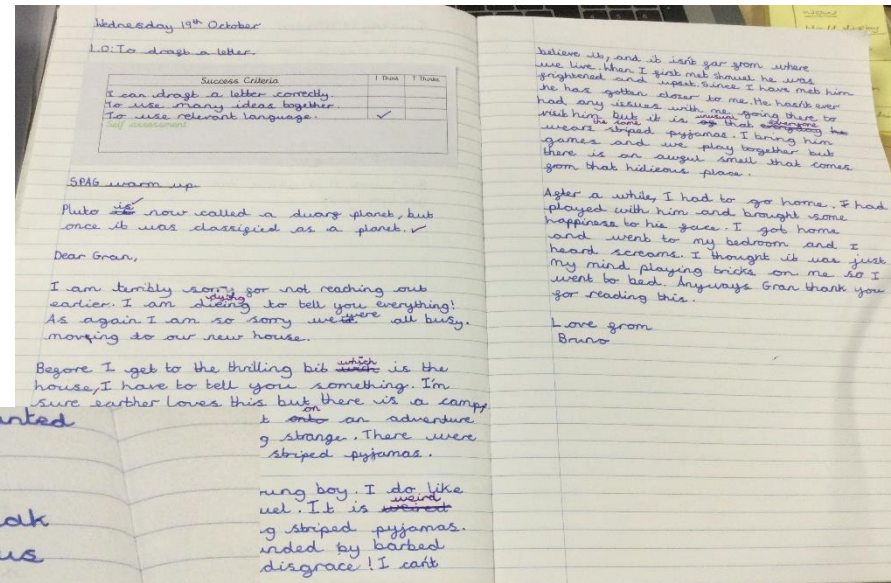
What did they do for fun?

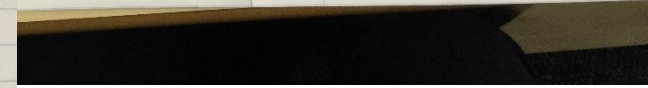

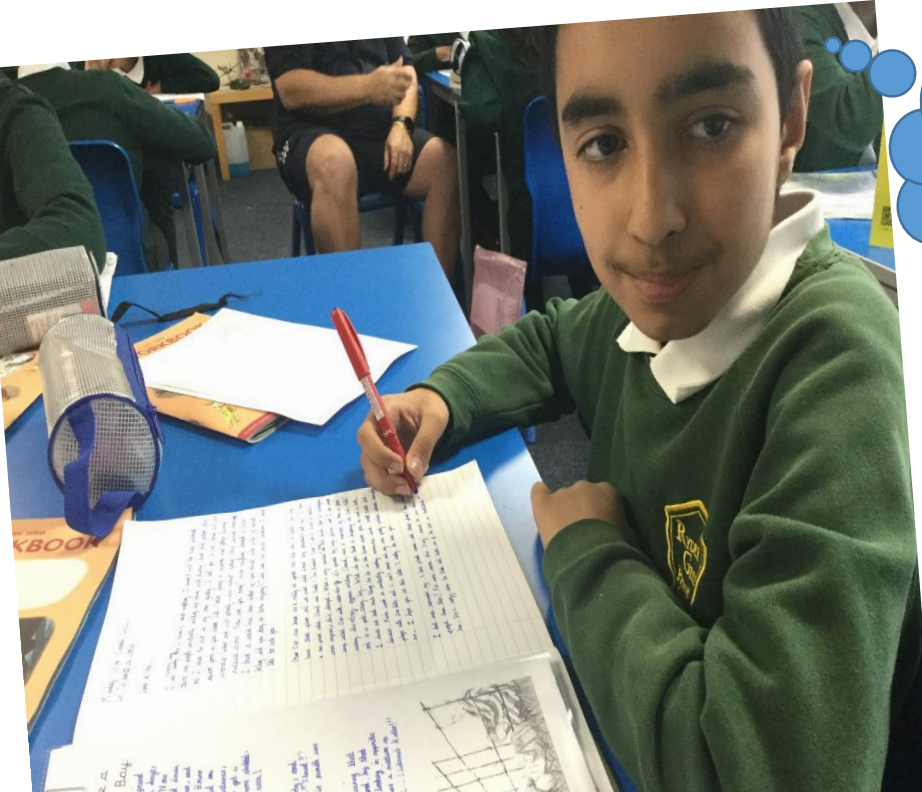

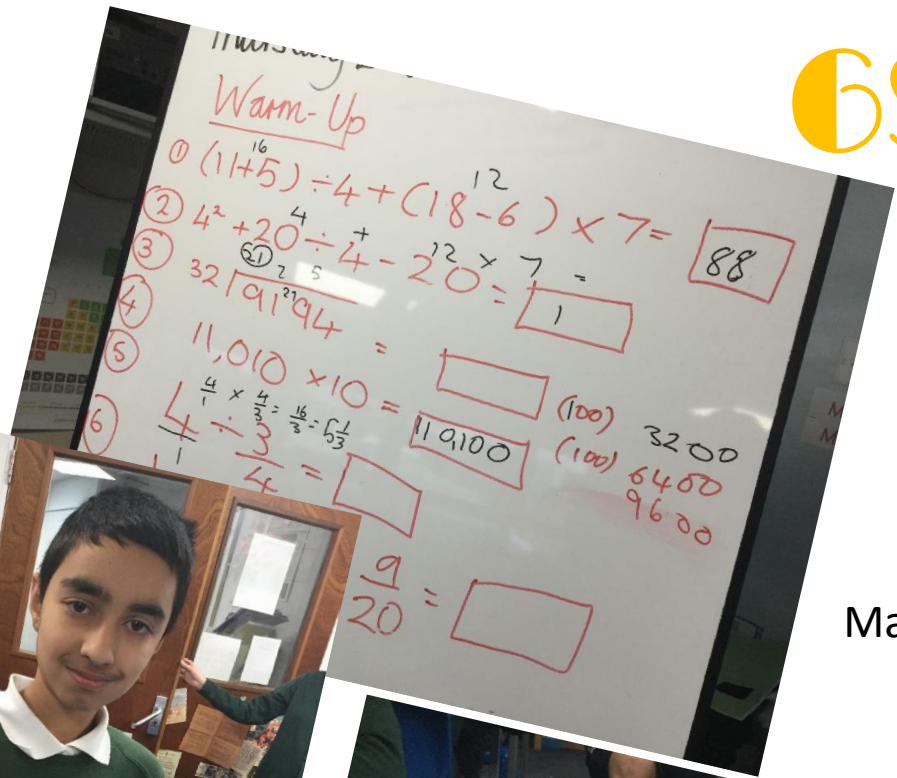
Agter several hours, Bruno decided to sneak out and meet up with a little nervous boy ~~called~~ ^{called} Shmuel.

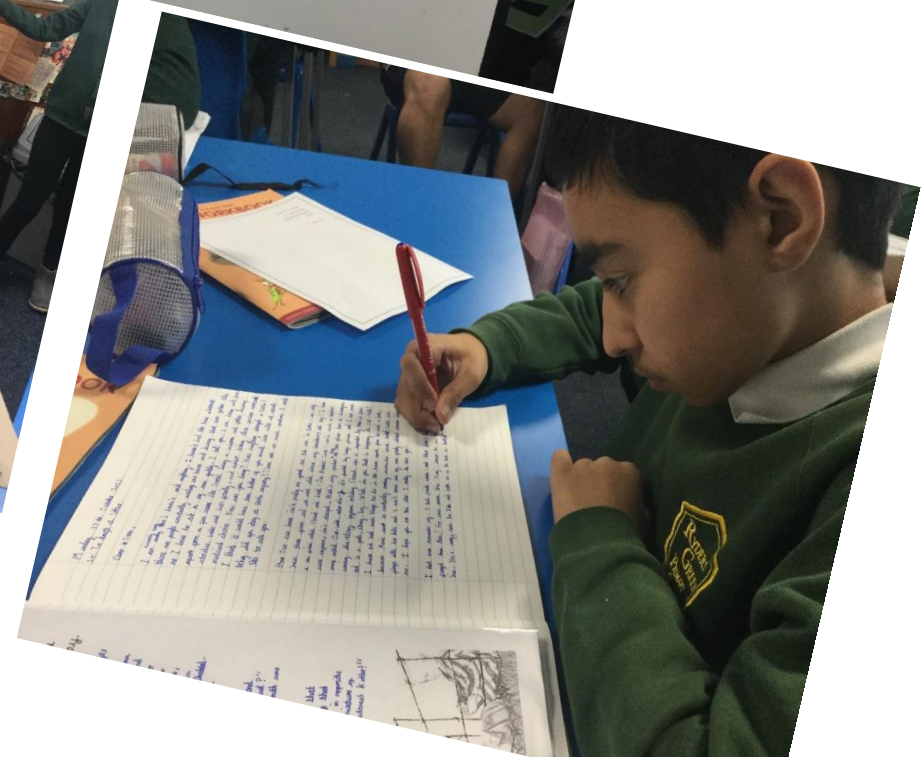
