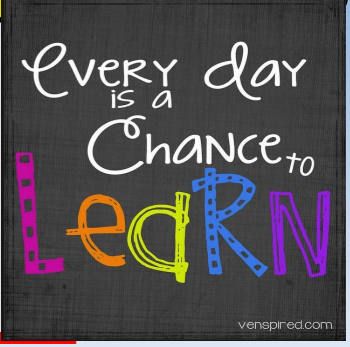

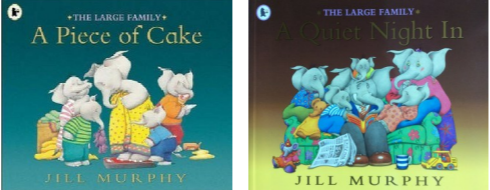


In English we will be looking at the following texts:

In Music (Expressive Arts and Design) we will: copy rhythms by listening and repeating.

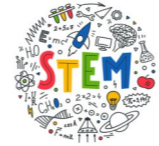


In the Imagination Studio we will:
