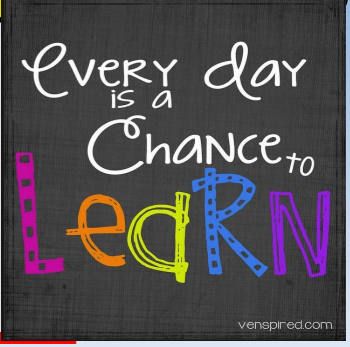

In Phonics we will be learning our letter sounds and blending them to read words and sentences.

In Reading our focus is..

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will:

- Take turns, share and look after our friends.

In R.E. (Understanding of the World) we will:

Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

In Physical development we will:

- We will be looking at different movement skills including rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running,

Maths:

- We will be representing numbers to 5.
- We will be exploring the language of position
- We will be exploring shapes.
- We will begin to look at finding one more and one less than a number.

- Go on a Winter's journey through the story of The Gruffalo.

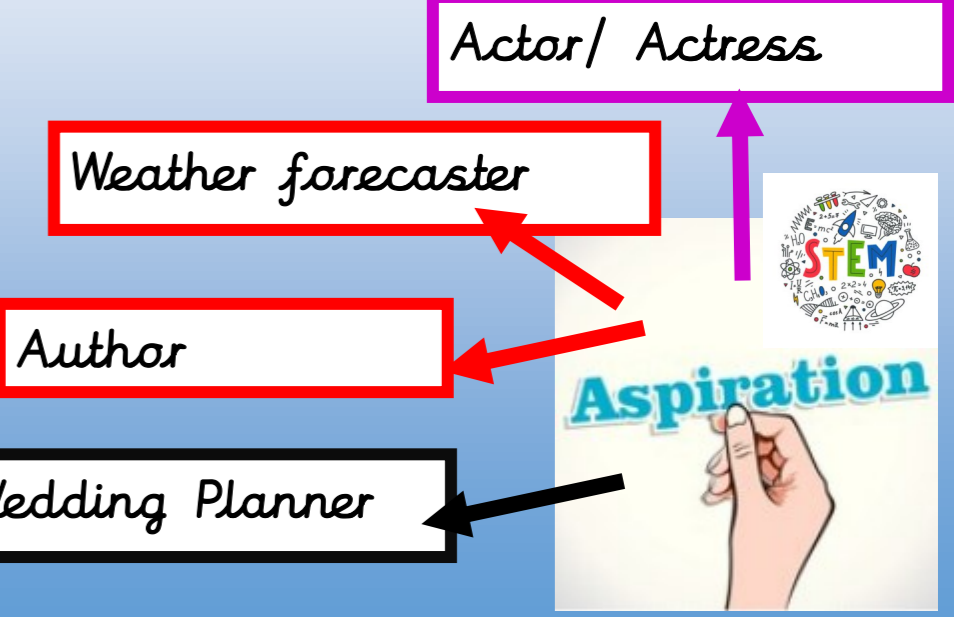
In Geography (Understanding of the World) we will:
