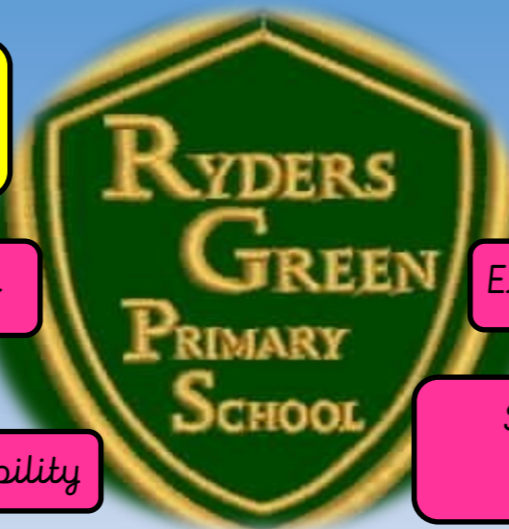

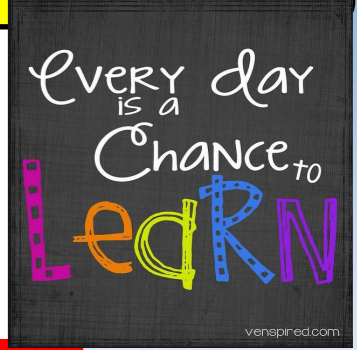

In English we will:

- Learn how to write a setting description with a focus on detail and fluency.
- Learn how to connect with a text in more depth.
- Learn how to connect with characters through identification of thoughts and feelings.
- Learn how to write a diary entry.
- Learn how to link a text to our own experiences.
- Learn how to write the retelling of a story.



In Reading our focus is..

In RSHE we will:

- Discuss and set personal goals.
- Learn about the importance of rules, rights and responsibilities.
- Discuss rewards, consequences and responsible choices.

In R.E we will:

- Learn about different festivals that are celebrated across different religions.

In P.E we will:

- Develop basic ball skills, including; hand-eye co-ordination, speed, agility and changing direction.

Maths:

- Learn the value of each digit in a 3-digit number.
- Learn to partition a 3-digit number in a range of ways.
- Learn to compare numbers to 1,000.
- Learn to find 1, 10, 100, more or less.
- Learn how to use and estimate numbers on a number line.
- Learn how to add and subtract with numbers up to 3-digit numbers.



In Music we will:

- Learn to play the trumpet.



In Computing we will:

- Learn what cyber bullying is and how to stay safe online.
- Learn how to create an animation using Scratch.

In History we will:

- Learn to locate ancient Egypt in time and place.
- Learn about the importance of the Egyptian landscape in peoples lives.
- Learn about the importance of artefacts including Tutankhamun.
- Learn about the process of mummification.



In French we will:

- Learn basic language such as greetings, my name is and numbers.

Where could my learning lead me?

In Science we will:
