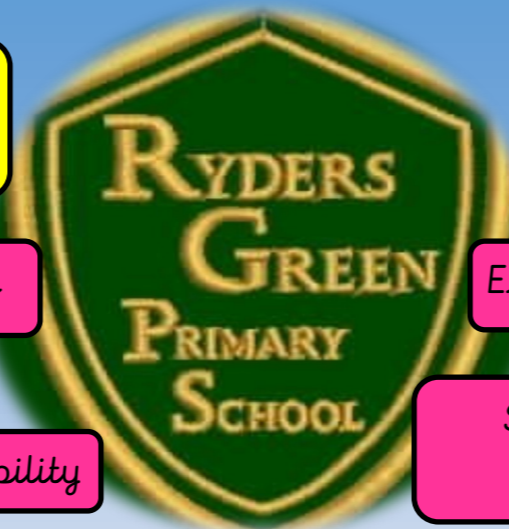

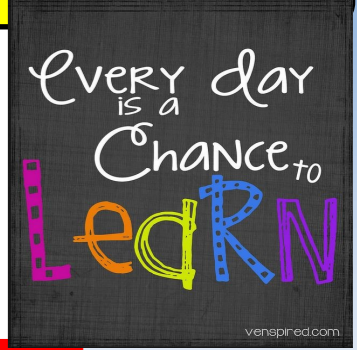

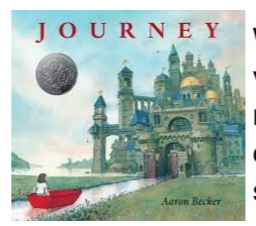

 - (Spelling test every Friday)



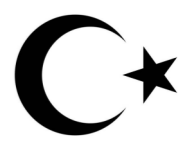
- In Reading our focus is:**

 - Learn how to present data about the weather.



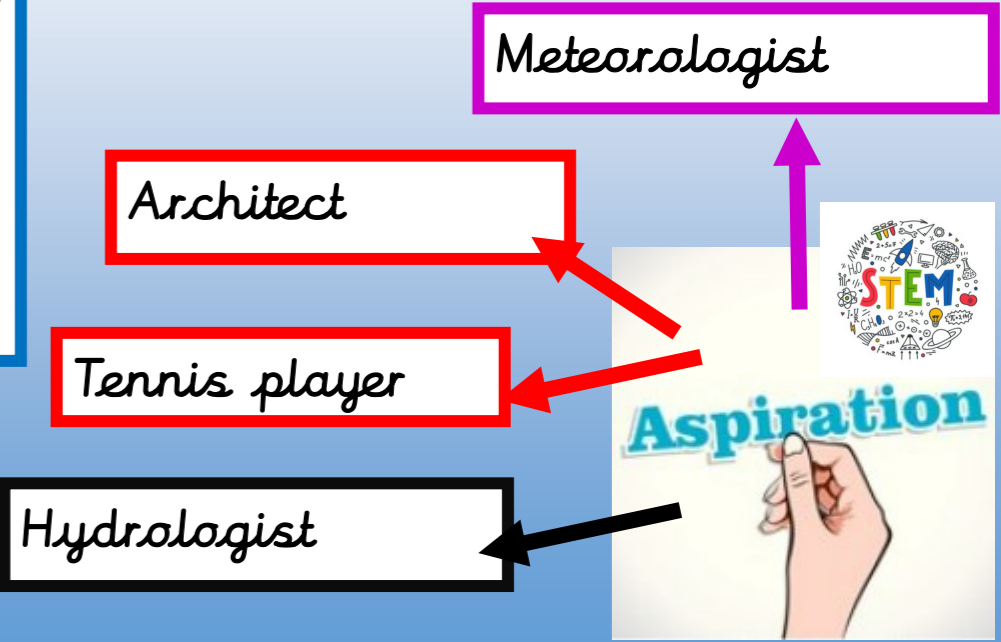
- In Geography we will:**

 - Complete a "beat the floods" STEM project.



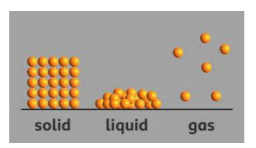
- In French we will:**
