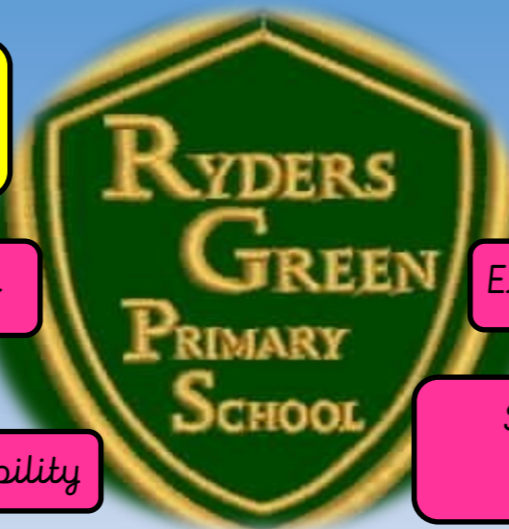

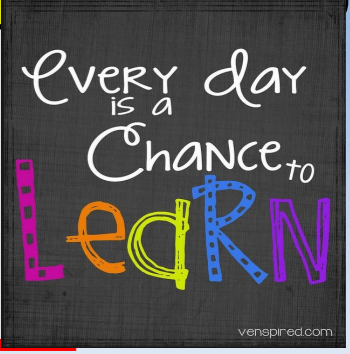

  - Learn how to code and how to correct any code that doesn't work.



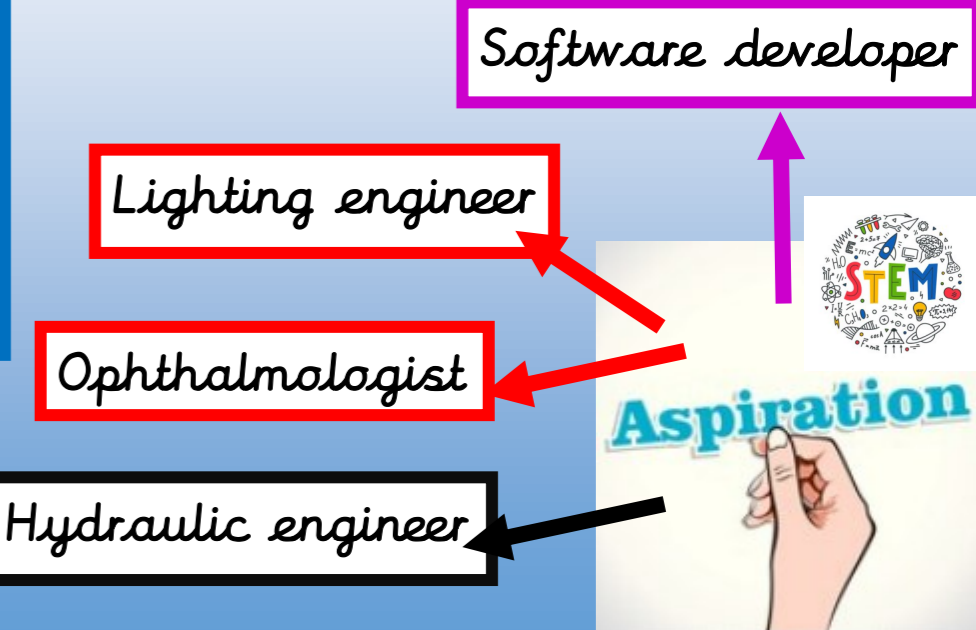
- In history we will:**
