### **Attendance**

#### Our attendance target is 97%

#### Leave of absence during term time

We strongly recommend that you check term dates with school - especially before you book a holiday.

The Local Authority will issue fines to parents whose children have unauthorised absence from school. This can be anything from £60 - £120 per adult and per child and can rise to £2500 each!

If children are taken out of school during term time it is classed as unauthorised absence. If it extends to more than 10 days we can and will remove your child from roll. Attendance Services collect all absences and will take further action if necessary.

Please think carefully before booking a holiday in term time. You should consider the potential impact on your child's education. Statistics show that 10 days' absence in any academic year means pupils' learning suffers and they do worse in tests and exams. Remember that schools do not have to provide work for students taking holidays during term time.

If appointments in school time cannot be avoided please ensure an appointment card (or letter) is handed to the school office prior to the appointment. If your child is absent through sickness please provide medical proof in the way of medication labels or prescription slip. Wherever possible attend school prior to appointments and return to school following the appointment. You should not keep your child off school for the whole morning, afternoon or all day.

#### Remember .....

You may get fined or even lose your child's school place if you take your children out of school during term time.

Antibiotics ..... We can administer your child's antibiotics just call by the office and complete a form. There is no need to keep your child off school.

Normal General Admission Ticket - £10 per person Joint General Admission - 1 paying adult and includes free entry for 1 child (up to the age of 14) - £10 Concession Ticket - For students, Unemployed, people receiving benefits and Individuals 60+ - £7

If purchasing one of the joint admissions for 1 paying adult and 1 free child, you need only click 1 when asked for the amount of people (1 ticket = 2 people).

You can purchase tickets for stalls or the balcony, prices do not differ depending on seating but please note that under 14's cannot be seated on the front row balcony due to the safety regulations of the concert venue.
