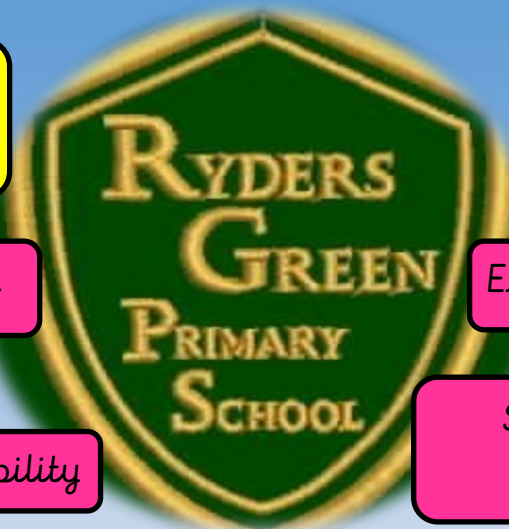


Ryders Green Primary School

- Learn to play the violin.



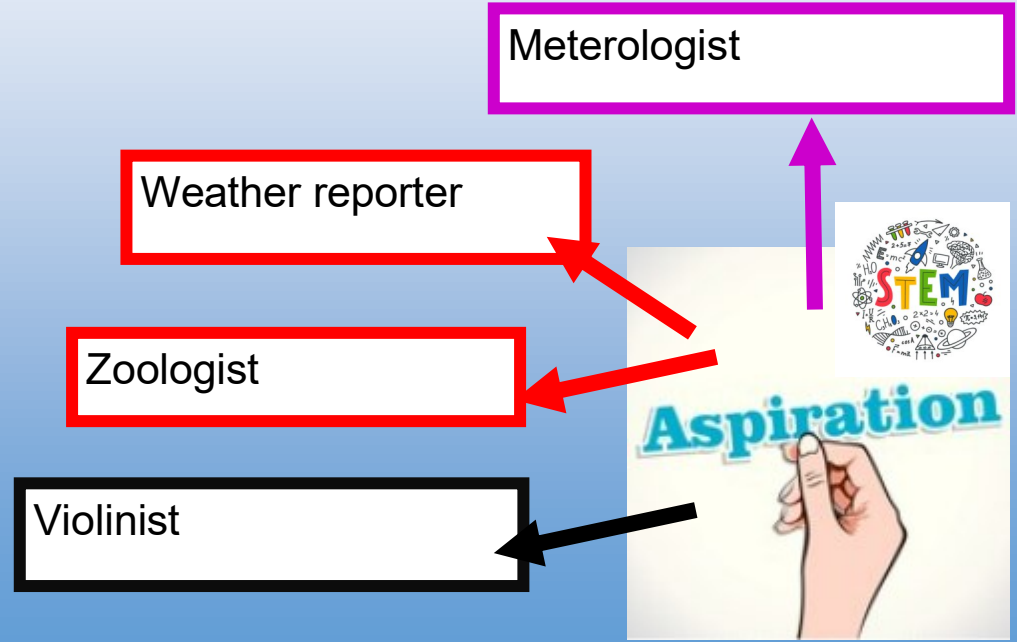
In Computing we will:
