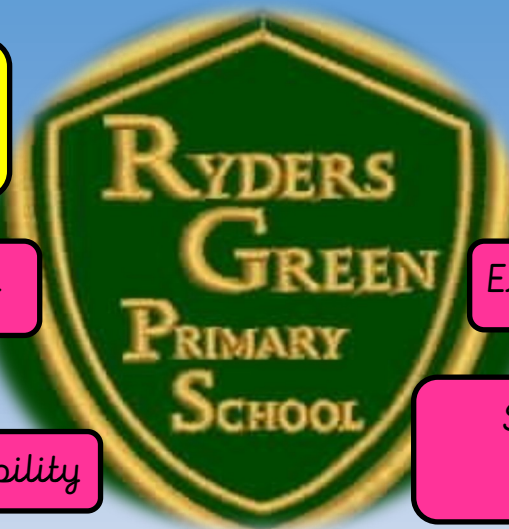

At home:

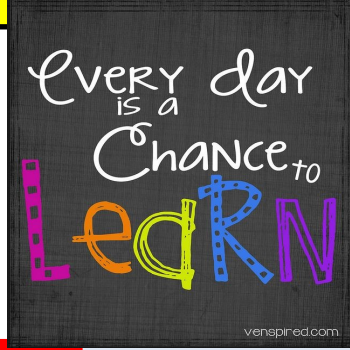
- Your child should aim to read for 5-10 minutes every day. You will need to sign their reading record.

In Computing we will:

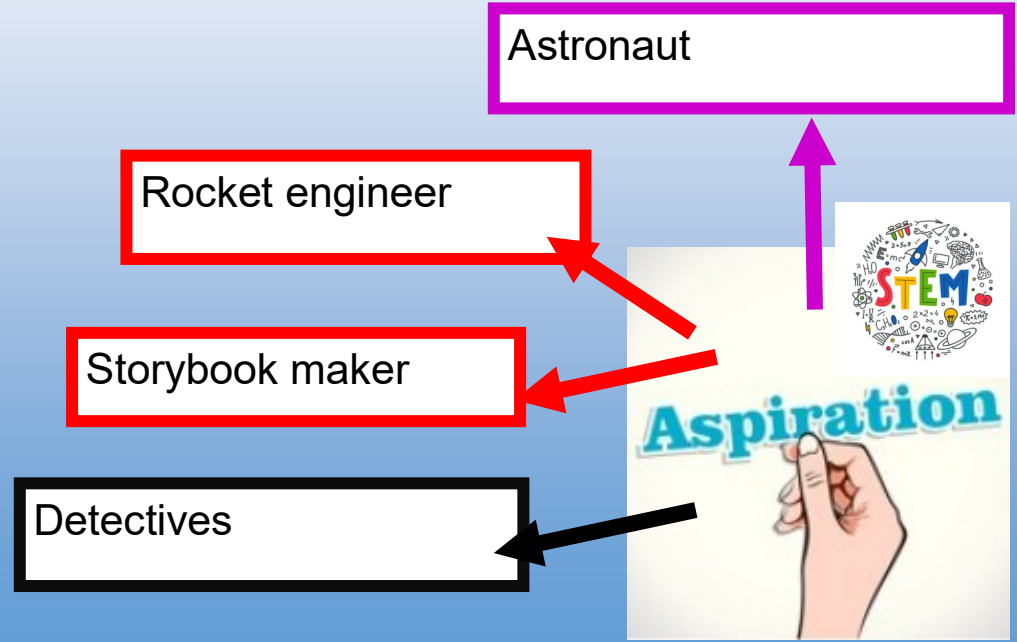
- solve a mystery by reading, sending and replying to emails, and by listening to a witness statement
