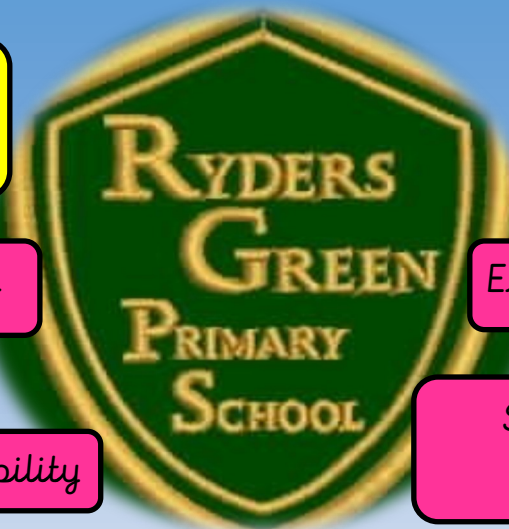

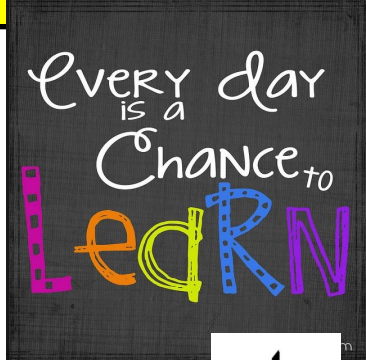

In Reading our focus is..

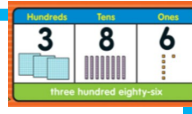
- In RSHE we will:**

 - Learn about the process of mummification.



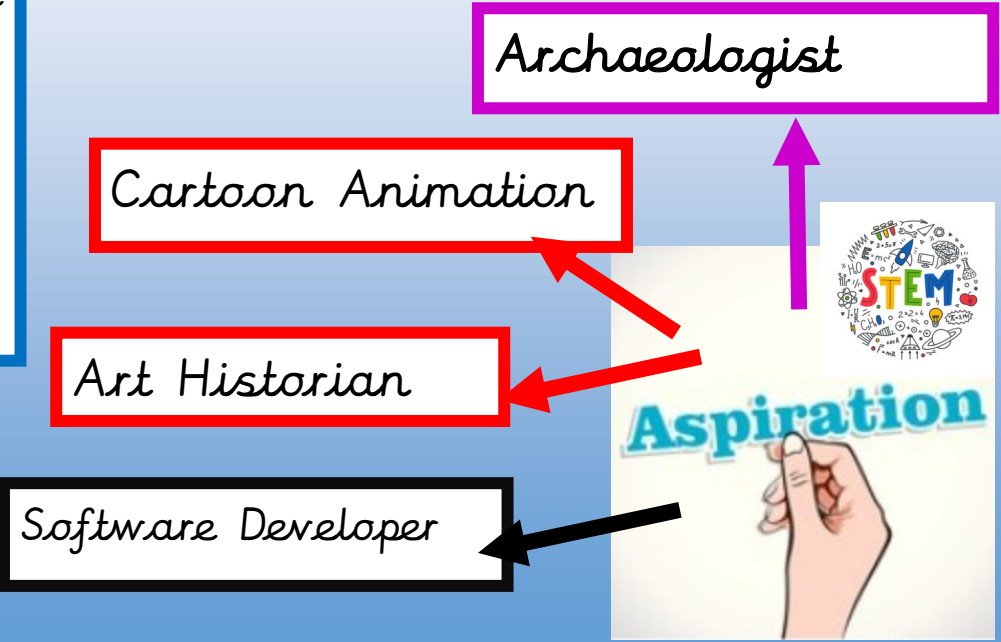
- In French we will:**
