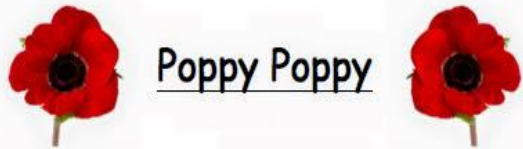


Year 5 half term homework project
