World war I was a global conflict that took place between 1914 and 1918. Also known as the great war or first world war it was fought primarily in Europe but it also spread to the Middle East, East Africa and Asia. 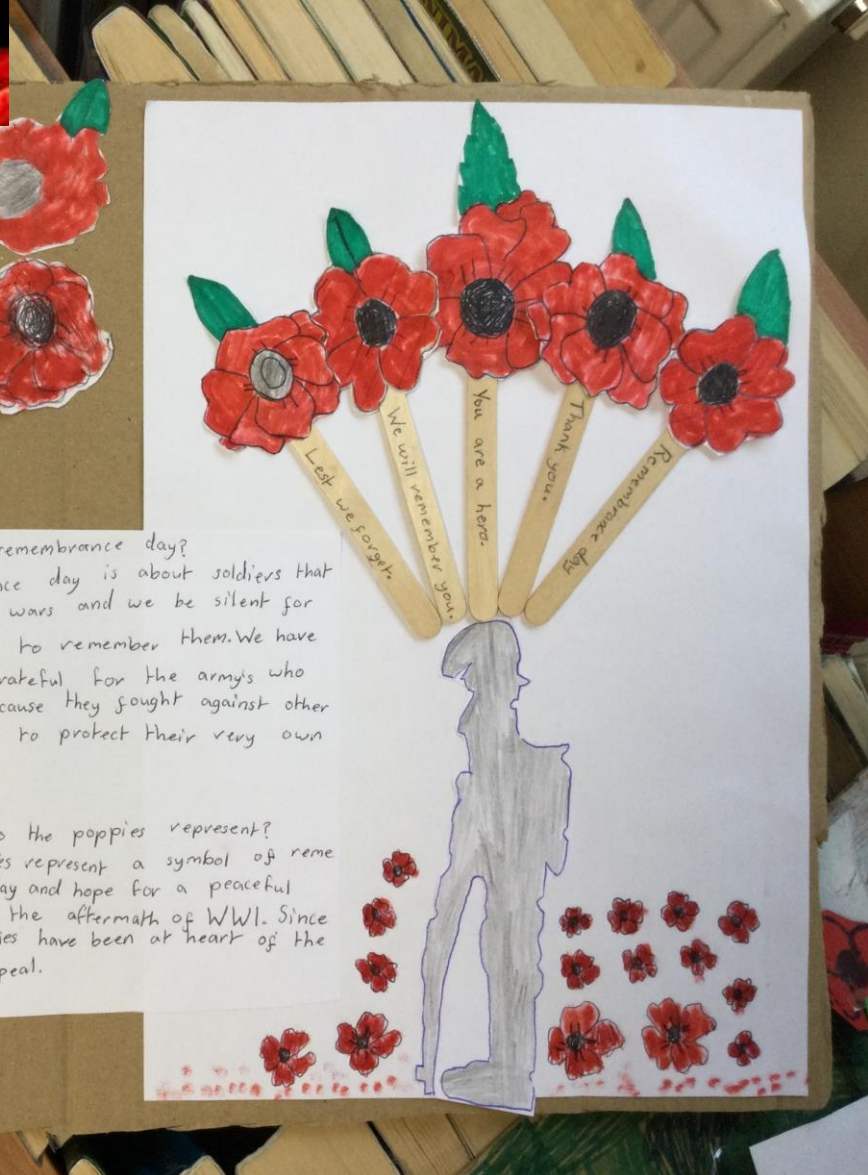
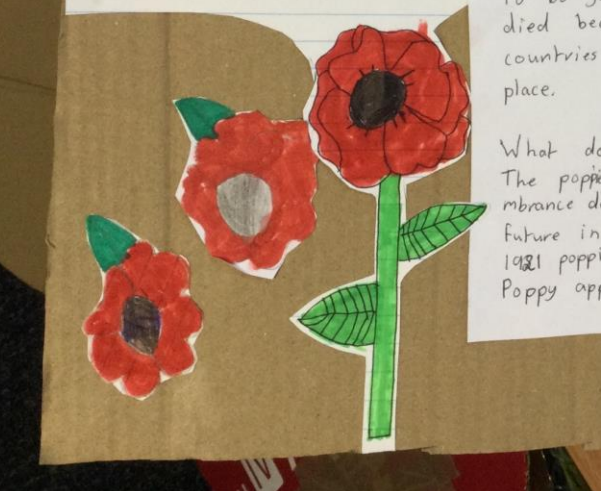
Remembrance day poem

As the bomb comes down and lit.

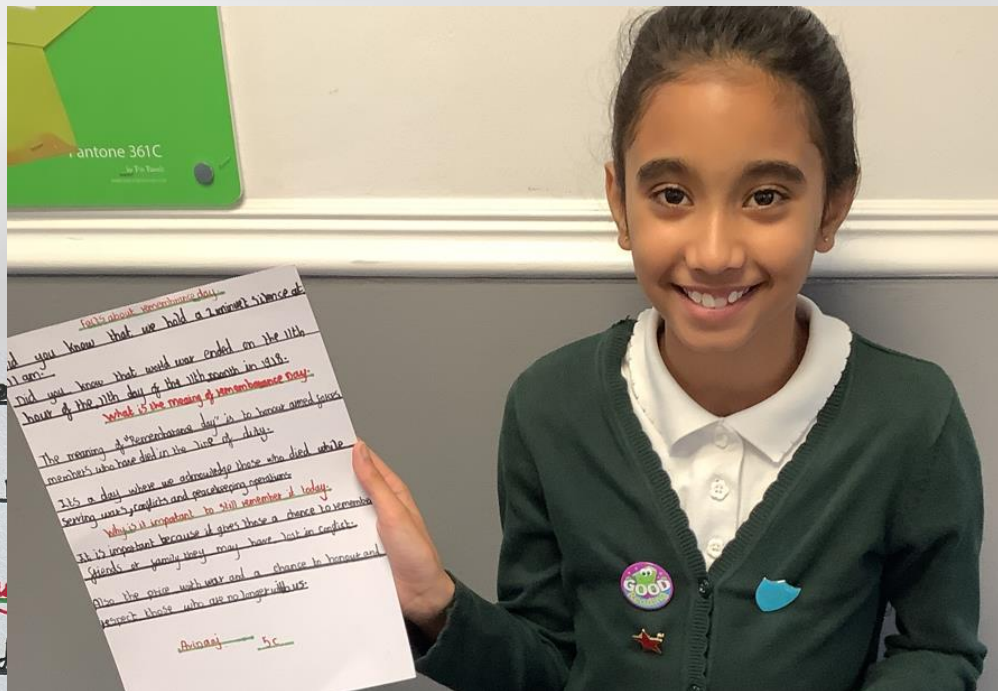
Remember those who fought,

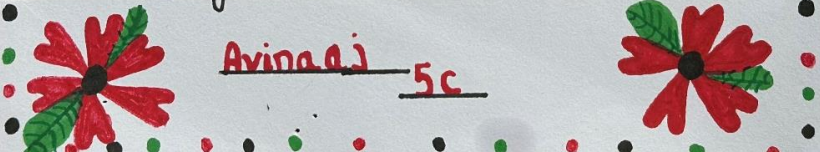

What do the poppies represent.

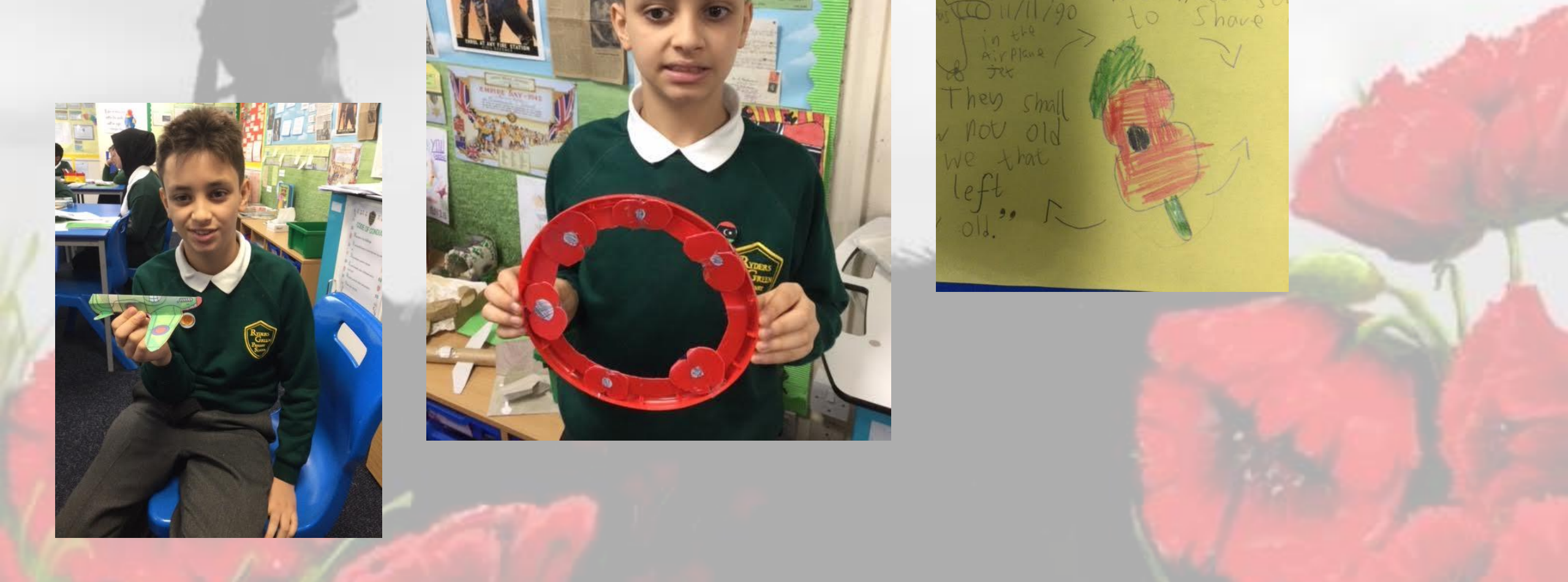
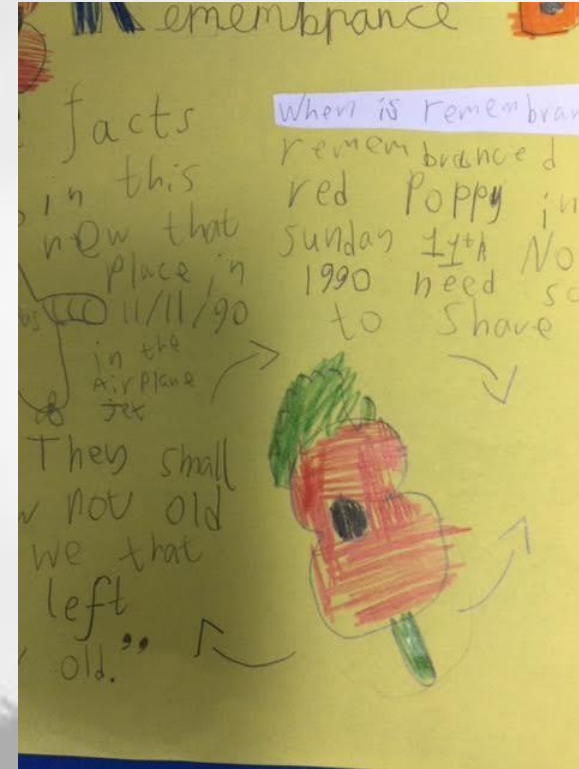
• The poppies represent all those who lost their lives on active service, from the beginning of the first world war right up to represent up to present day. Wearing a poppy is a show of support for the service.
