- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.



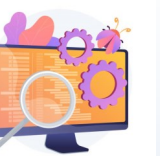
In RSHE we will:

- Learn how to create a talking book, by recording our voices and sound effects.



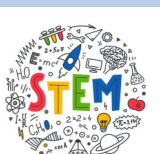
