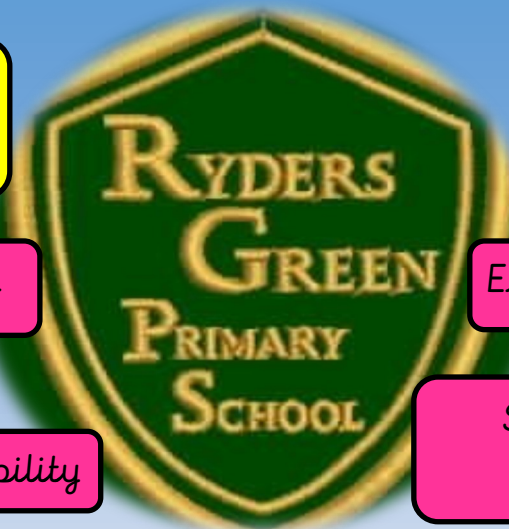

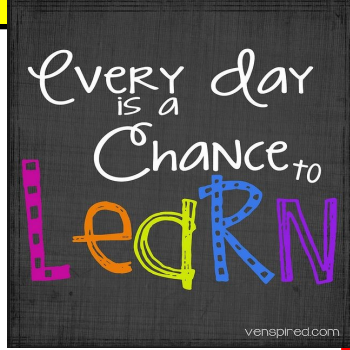

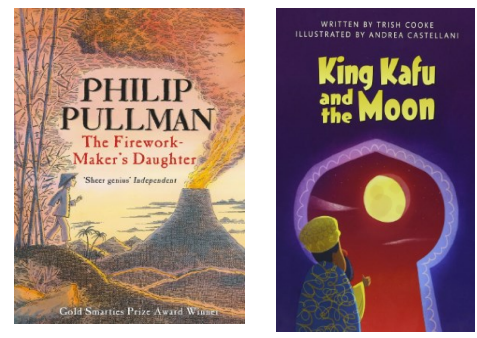

 - Learn how to multiply and divide by 3,4 and 8.

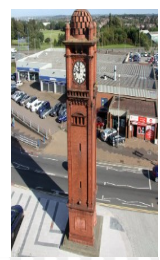
- In Music we will:**
