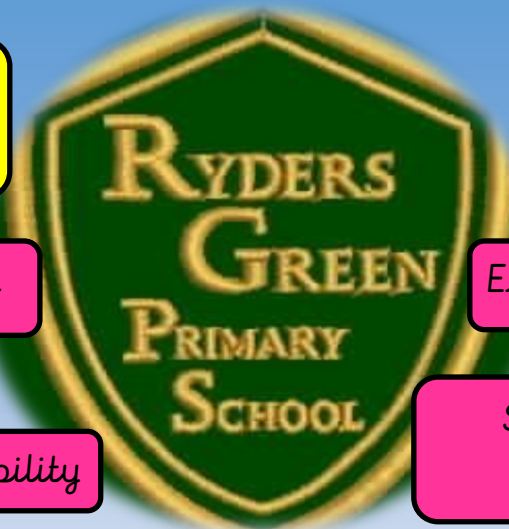

- Listen to a range of stories in an immersive environment.

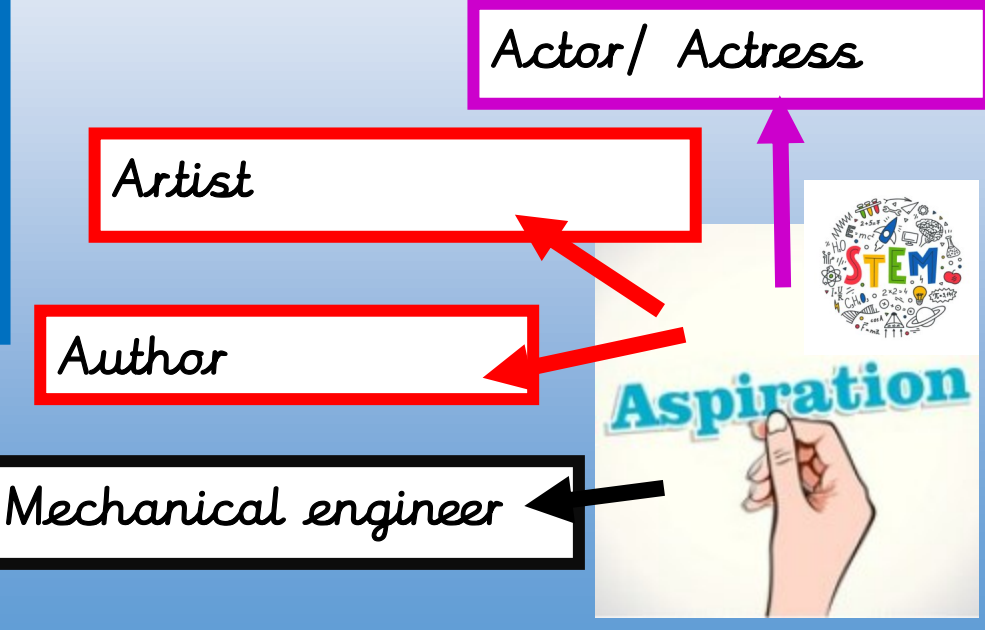
In Geography (Understanding of the World) we will:
