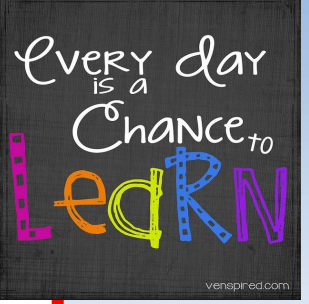

In English we will be looking at the following texts:

In phonics we will be developing our listening skills, through listening and distinguishing sounds. We will also focus on learning a wide range of nursery.

In Reading our focus is....

In Personal, Social and Emotional.

Select and use activities and resources, with help when needed.

In R.E. (Understanding of the World) we will:

The first topic in Nursery is all about me where the children will learn and talk about their religion and how it is different to other children's.

In Physical development we will:

- Start developing their movement and balancing.

In the Imagination Studio we will:

- Learn about the families and experience the books setting scenery.

Maths:

- We will be recognising amounts that are more, less and the same.
- We will explore and build with shapes and objects.
- We will be exploring repeating patterns..
- We will be learning to hear and say number names.
- We will also be singing a range of number and counting songs, such as 5 little speckled frogs.

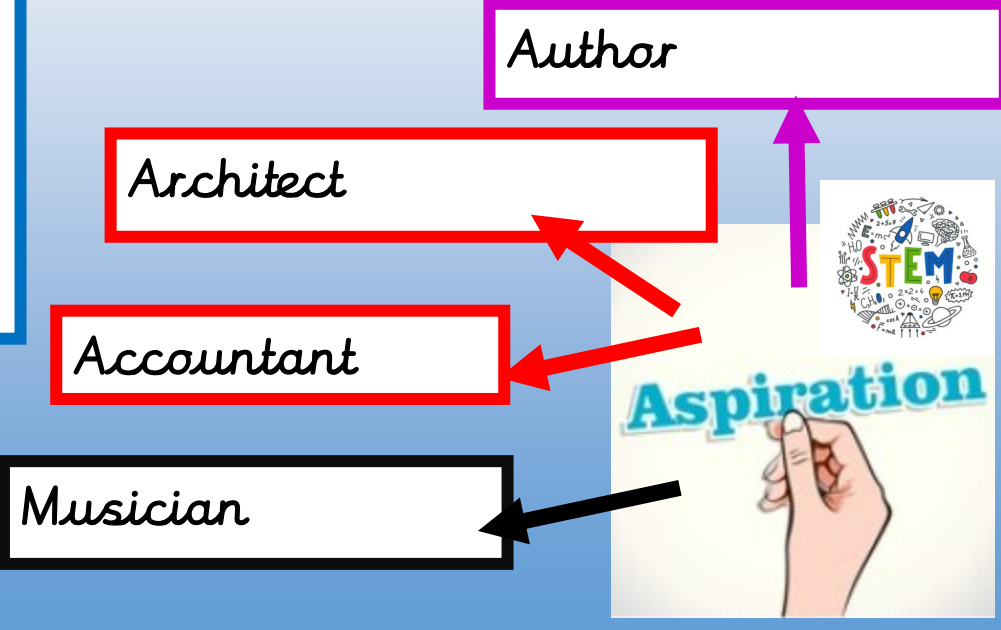
In Music (Expressive Arts and Design) we will: Playing instrument and listening to adults play instrument as the children are learning to experiment with sounds.

In Geography (Understanding of the World) we will: Exploring different locations. This time we are setting into Nursery and getting used to a new setting. The children will be experience what the Nursery and school is like.

In Communication and Language we will:

- Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember what has happened.

In Science (Understanding of the World) we will:

- Learn to use our senses. We will explore the natural materials in the garden.
- We will say what we see using key vocabulary.

In the Creative Area we will:

- Make imagination and complex 'small worlds' with blocks and construction kit.
- Take part in pretend play, using an object to represent something else.
