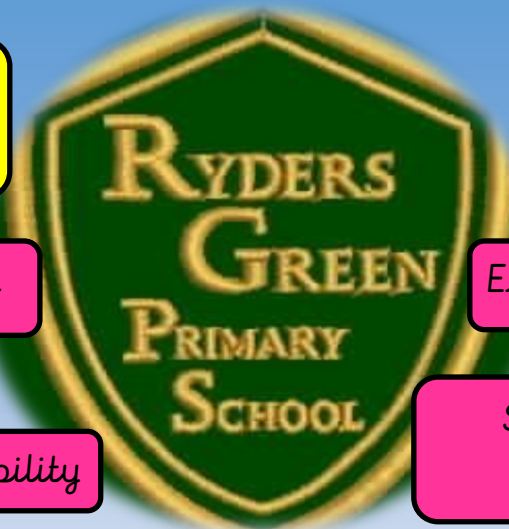

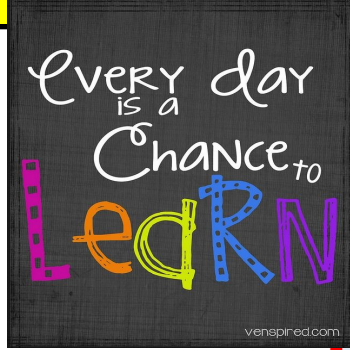

 - We will be combining our skills of rolling, jumping and balancing into sequencing.



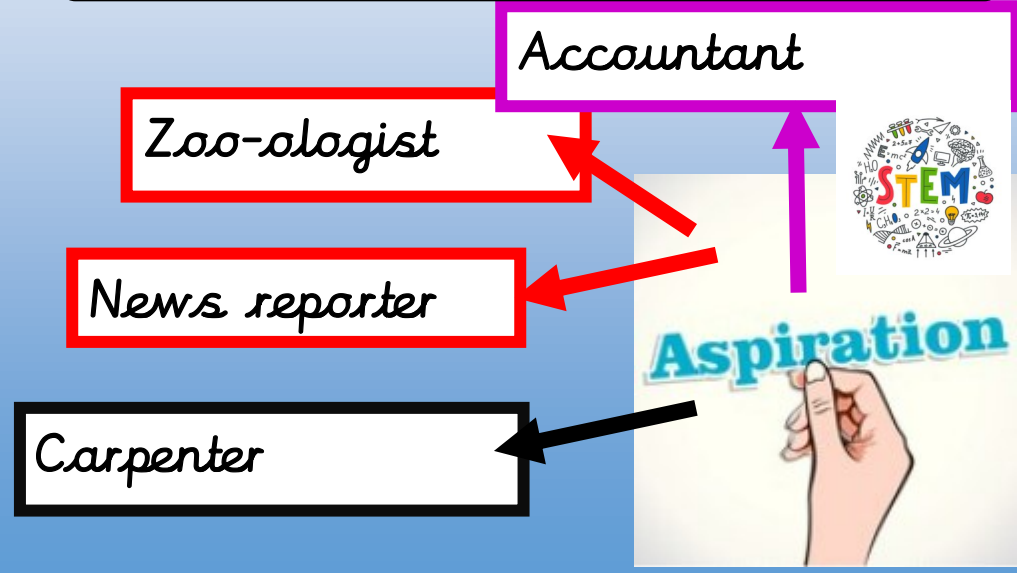
- In History we will:**
