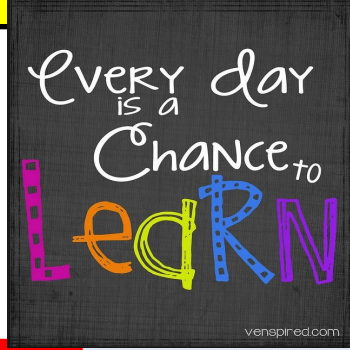

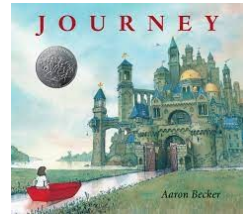


In English we will:

In Reading our focus is:



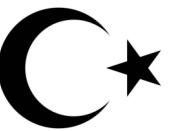
We will also use a variety of fiction and non-fiction text during our reading sessions.

- (Times tables test every Thursday)



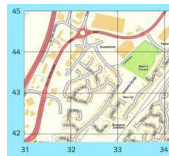
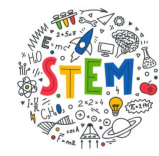
In Music we will:

- Learn key vocabulary to my town.



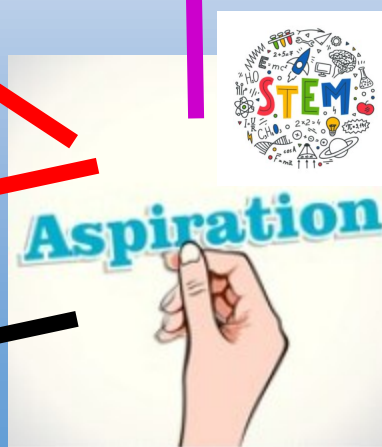

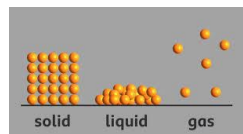
