 - The events of the Trojan War



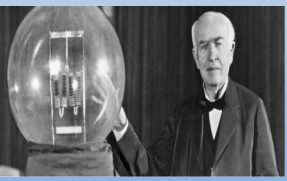
- In Computing we will:**
