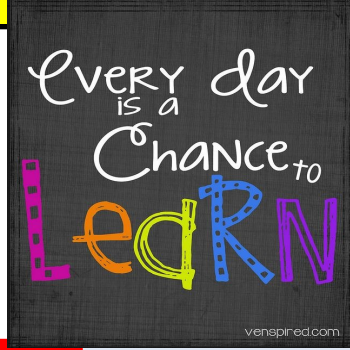

## In Reading our focus is:



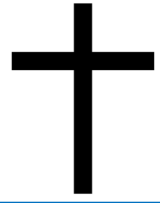
We will also use a variety of fiction and non-fiction text during our reading sessions.

- Learn about key countries and major cities in North and South America.

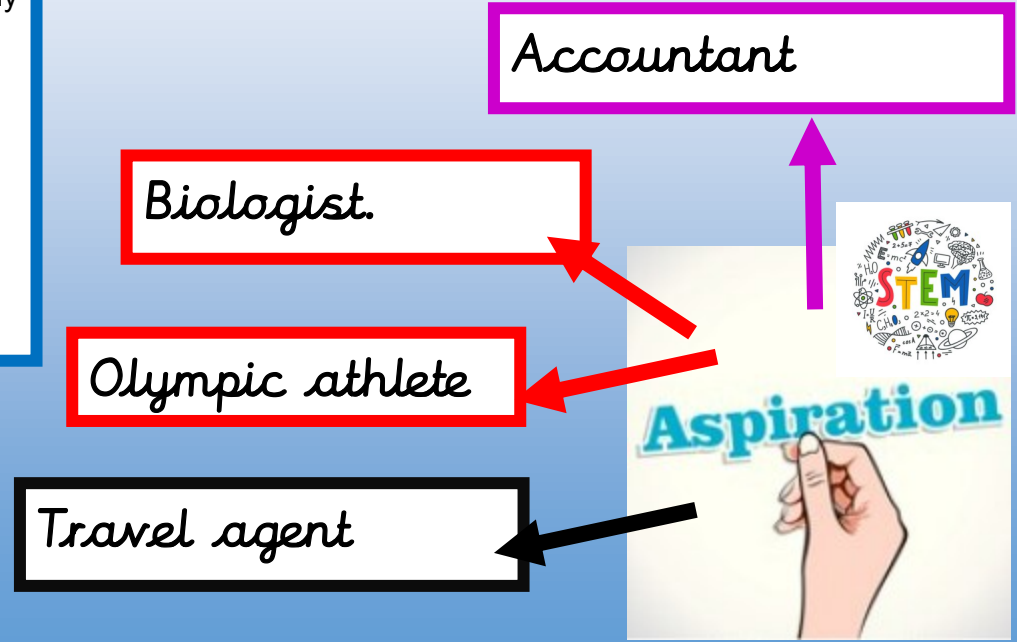


## In French we will:
