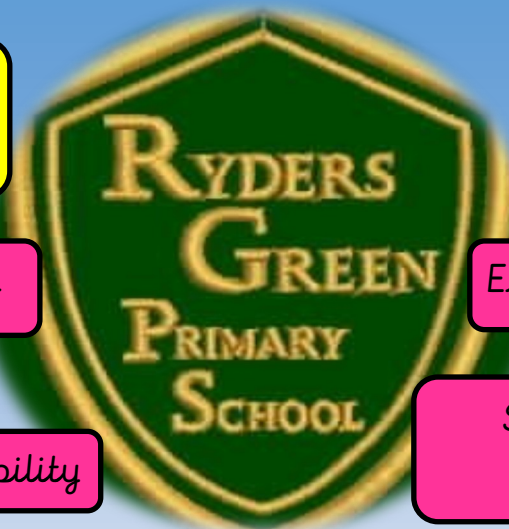

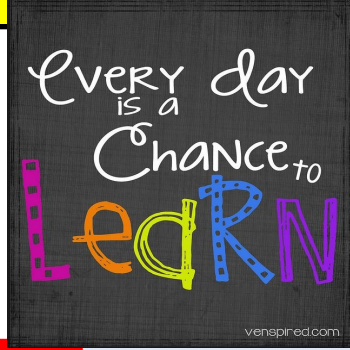

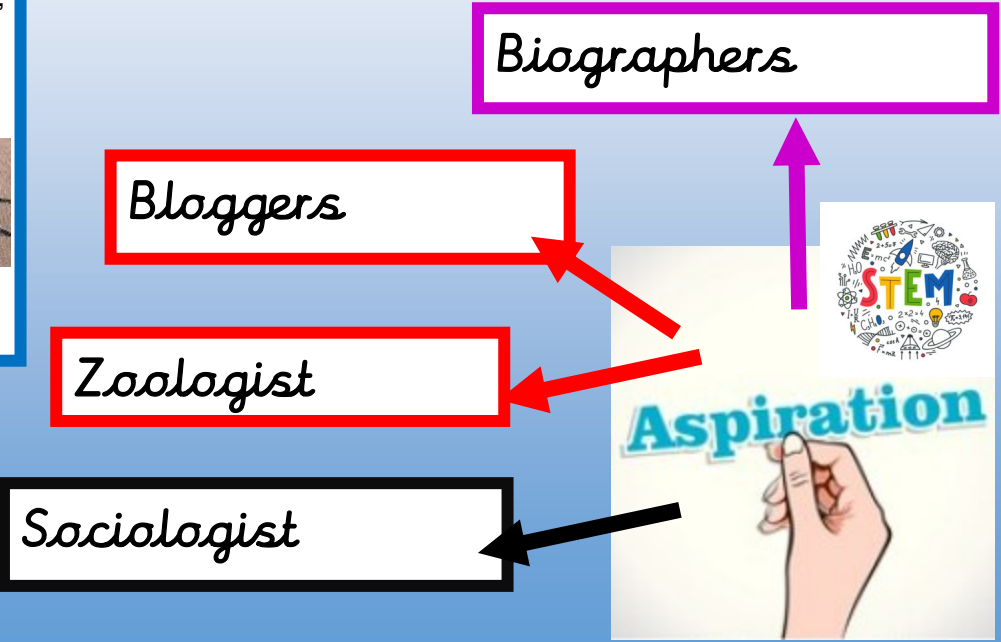


- In Computing we will:**
